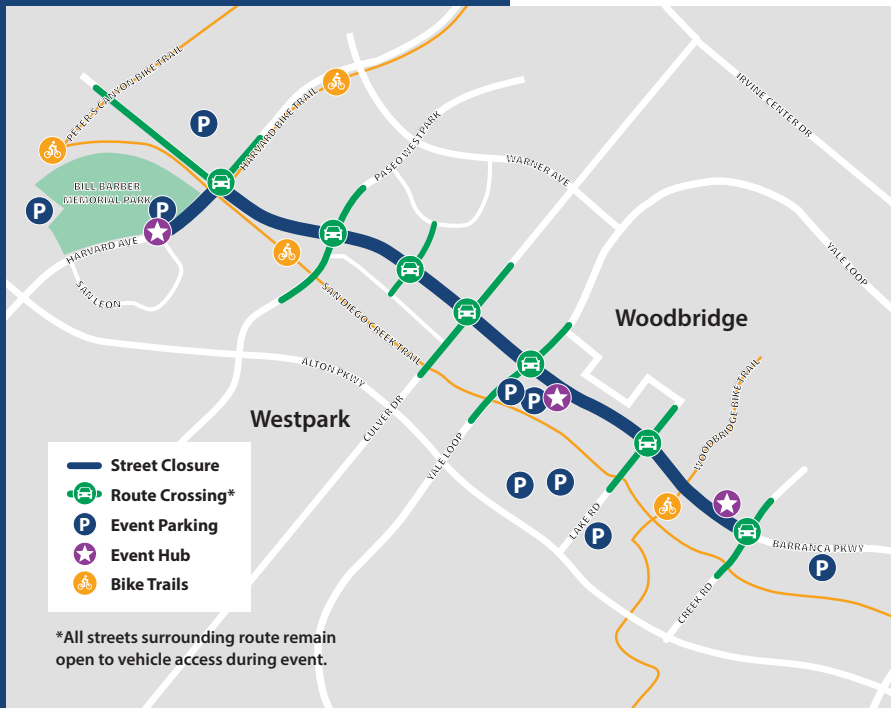

Street Closure Hours:
7 a.m.–6:30 p.m.

If you live or work on the CicloIrvine route, please note the following restrictions during the closure hours:

There will be no street parking along the route, which will be closed to car traffic from 10 a.m.–6 p.m. (approximately) for the event.

Most driveways along the route will be closed as well from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Keep a look out for signs to indicate driving detours.
